SOUTH AFRICA – A RIGHTEOUS NATION THAT KEEPS THE TRUTH!

“And I have put My words in your mouth; I have covered you with the shadow of My hand, That I may plant the heavens, Lay the foundations of the earth, And say to Zion, 'You are My people.'” Isaiah 51:16

When we gathered for our national conference on 17th and 18th November to birth a righteous nation, that is what we did. Through prophetic prayer we planted the heavens and laid a new foundation for South Africa to build a righteous nation upon. We raised an altar for the nation and opened the gates for a righteous South Africa that keeps the truth to enter in (Isaiah 26:2).

For this to move from being a prophetic declaration to a manifest reality the Lord gave us certain instructions, the first being that we cannot have a righteous nation without a righteous church, and for that there needs to be a new wineskin. South Africa is the most liberal nation in the African continent leading in the wrong direction. This is because the church is also liberal and compromised. But the Lord can and will turn the nation around as we raise a new priesthood. Laban Jjumba gave us many prophetic pictures to give us vision to prepare the new wineskin that will lead the church and the nation into righteousness (see the conference notes attached).

His first example was during the time of Eli, when his sons Hophni and Phinehas, had brought the priesthood into disrepute through their sexual immorality and covetousness, similar to what we see in the church today. However, God brought judgment on them and raised up a new faithful priest who in one generation turned the nation around. This was Samuel, a man who heard God’s instructions and faithfully carried them out and who at the end of his life had a testimony of absolute personal integrity. At the end of this year 2011, a year of God’s righteous judgment, which begins in the house of God (1 Peter 4:17), the Hophni and Phinehas priesthood must die and a Samuel priesthood arise in South Africa.

There is a serious contest for the spiritual rulership of our nation which requires the “royal; priesthood” (1 Peter 2:9) to take up its God given responsibility as kings and priests to our God (Revelation 1:6) and establish Jesus as the righteous ruler of South Africa and increase His government upon the land (Isaiah 9:7). We must raise altars in every province in villages, towns and cities to establish the Lordship of Jesus throughout the nation.

Most people have already heard that on 6th January 2012 the ANC as part of its Centenary celebrations intend to build a kraal and hold a night vigil calling on the spirits of the founding fathers of the ANC, dedicating the ANC and the nation to the ancestors. The result of this

is making a covenant with death on behalf of the nation (Isaiah 28:14-18). God gives us the right to choose life or death and it is important that we make known to the Lord throughout the land that we choose life (Deut 30:19) through Jesus Christ our Lord (John 14:6).

We therefore ask you to ensure that there is a night of prayer held in your town, village, province from 18h00 on 6th January through until 06h00 on the 7th. Let us know what has been organized in your area in order to let others in your territory join. This is the time for the Body of Christ to act as one frustrating the enemy who always seeks to divide us, and in so doing we will receive the blessing of the Lord (Psalm 133).

In Free State there will be an all-night prayer initiative on Naval Hill, Bloemfontein from 18h00 on the 6th of January, 2012 until 06h00 of the morning of the 7th of January, 2012. This initiative is to strengthen a prayer altar that was raised on 3 November 2001, when South African leaders, intercessors and representatives of all racial groups gathered at Naval Hill to dedicate South Africa to the Lord Jesus Christ. An altar was laid with stones from towns and cities across South Africa. This was done to celebrate the Lordship of Jesus Christ in our nation. At the conference, we were challenged once again by the prophetic words that have been given over South Africa that affect not only our own destiny as a nation but the destiny of the continent and beyond. We read in scripture how when prophecies were given to the nation of Israel, the Lord had to find those who would take him at His word and both pray and act upon it. Moses was the answer to the cry of God's people in Egypt fulfilling the prophecy given to Abraham that Israel would be enslaved for 400 years and then delivered; Daniel prayed through the prophetic word of Jeremiah and the 70 years of captivity came to an end; Anna prayed through the promise of the Messiah and saw Him born and brought into the temple. We need to take up the prophecies God has given us and pray them through to manifestation.

One of the prophecies given by Kim Clements was that SA would have a God fearing president **if we prayed**. We are currently ruled by an ungodly government that passes ungodly laws. If we want this to change in 2014 we must pray asking the Lord who has He chosen to be our president. As Samuel was commissioned to anoint David before he became king, He can do also with us, if we take time to pray and seek His face.

SAPMC has the mission to change the mindset of the church and to show the place of spiritual warfare in the nation. We have been schooled in running congregations, not territories and the mindset of pastors must be changed from local church mentality to territorial. We are transitioning the church from emphasising personal salvation to territorial and national salvation.

If you believe and I believe, and we together pray, the Holy Spirit must come down and South Africa will be saved!
