MONDAY 17 APRIL 2023

COMMITMENT

"Now therefore, fear the LORD, serve Him in sincerity and in truth,"... (Joshua 24:14).

Let us pray

Heavenly Father, **I want to know and love You more** each day for Proverbs 8:17 says that You love those who love You and those who seek You diligently will find You.

Ask the Lord for a heart that cries out for **the elderly** in your neighbourhood to seek the Lord anew so that they might find Him (1 Chronicles 28:9).

Pray for **the Church** to acknowledge God and for her heart's desire to serve Him wholeheartedly and with a willing mind, for the Lord searches every heart and understands every desire and every thought she might have.

Practical tip

Read the Bible every day in a place of solitude. Pray and communicate your heart to Him.

TUESDAY 18 APRIL 2023

DEVOTED

Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving. (Colossians 4:2).

Let us pray

Lord, I only want to **fear You and serve You** in truth with all my heart for You have done great things for me (1 Samuel 12:24a).

Lift up to the Lord all **members of your congregation** to present their bodies as a living and holy sacrifice acceptable to God, which is their spiritual service of worship (Romans 12:1).

Cry out to the Lord for **the Church** to have the heart to walk in a manner worthy of the God who calls her into His own kingdom and glory (1 Thessalonians 2:12).

Practical tip

Spend time with the Lord in the Word, open your heart and wait on Him for He is very near to you.

WEDNESDAY 19 APRIL 2023

REVERENCE

Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. (Hebrews 12:28).

Let us pray

Father, I pray for myself to increase in peace, to be built up and **grow in the fear of the Lord** and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit.

Pray for **Christian leaders** to, by the fear of the Lord, keep away from evil thoughts and conduct for our God is a consuming fire.

Pray for **the Church** to be subordinate to one another in the fear of Christ for He is the LORD.

Practical tip

God is worthy of our reverence, and the more we know Him the more we will reverence Him and be in awe of Him – set a daily fixed time to wait on the Lord and spend time with Him.

THURSDAY 20 APRIL 2023

TRUST AND FAITH

And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; For You, LORD, have not forsaken those who seek You. (Psalm 9:10).

Let us pray

I pray for my heart to say of You, "He is my refuge and my fortress, **my God, in whom I trust.**"

Pray for **parents** to teach their children that without faith it is impossible to please God, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him (Hebrews 11:6).

Lift up **the Church** before God to find rest in Him, to return wholeheartedly back to Him; trust the Lord at all times and pour out her heart to Him for He is her mighty rock and refuge.

Practical tip

Read the promises in God's Word for it teaches us about trusting Him and having faith in Him during hard times e.g. Romans 1:17

FRIDAY 21 APRIL 2023

LISTEN WHEN GOD SPEAKS

Now the LORD came and stood and called as at other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" And Samuel answered, "Speak, for Your servant hears." (1 Samuel 3:10).

Let us pray

Father, **help me to be still**, and know that You are God; to stop fearing and acknowledge that You are God, my refuge and strength (Psalm 46:10-11).

Pray for **the government** to guard their steps and go near to God to listen carefully to His Word. Let their words be few and fear God.

Ask for **the Church** to be blessed by hearing God's Word and observing it faithfully (Luke 11:28).

Practical tip

Get into the habit of reading God's Word and hearing His voice before you share your prayer requests and petitions with God. Learning to hear His voice is essential to knowing God.

SATURDAY 22 APRIL 2023

PRAY WITHOUT CEASING

Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18).

Let us pray

Lord, I praise Your name for You have done glorious things; let this be known throughout the earth! Be merciful to me O Lord, for **I am calling on You constantly**.

Lift up **people in crises** before the Lord to not worry about their circumstances, but instead to pray about everything.

Pray for **the Church** to give thanks to the Lord and to call on His name; to make known His deeds among the peoples and make them remember that His name is exalted.

Practical tip

Prayer is a conversation with and a connection to the One Who breathed life into you. Use every opportunity to pray to God.

SUNDAY 23 APRIL 2023
POUR OUT YOUR HEART

And she [Hannah] was in bitterness of soul, and prayed to the LORD and wept in anguish. Then she made a vow and said, "O LORD of hosts, if You will indeed look on the affliction of Your maidservant and remember me, and not forget Your maidservant, but will give Your maidservant a male child, then I will give him to the LORD all the days of his life,..."
(1 Samuel 1:10-11).

Let us pray

Lord, help me **to pray from my heart**, to tell You about the longing I have for fellowship with You, my desperation to know You more and to be fruitful in prayer.

Pray for **traumatised people** to pour out their souls, clean out their hearts and give their cares and worries to the Lord in faith.

Pray for **the Church** to pour out her heart like water before the Lord and to lift up her hands toward Him for the lives of young children who faint from hunger at the head of every street (Lamentations 2:19).

Practical tip

Try not to keep God out of certain areas of your life by refusing to expose them to Him. Pouring out your heart before Him is like cleaning out a cluttered closet!
