



24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL 20 - 26 March 2023

MONDAY: 20 MARCH 2023

DAY AND NIGHT PRAYER

I have set watchmen upon your walls, O Jerusalem, who will never hold their peace day or night; you who [are His servants and by your prayers] put the Lord in remembrance [of His promises], keep not silence, and give Him no rest until He establishes Jerusalem and makes her a praise in the earth. (Isaiah 62:6-7, AMPC).

Let us pray

Thank the Lord that He has set men and women upon the *walls* of your nation who seek His face day and night.

Also, pray for more believers to respond to His call to stand as watchmen in prayer for your nation.

Pray for a spiritual awakening among God's people to call on Him night and day.

Ask God to strengthen the *watchmen on the wall* of your nation to remain steadfast in prayer, to be protected against the wiles of the enemy and continually remind God of His promises.

TUESDAY: 21 MARCH 2023

PERSIST IN PRAYER

And will not God bring about justice for his chosen ones, who cry out to him day and night? Will he keep putting them off? I tell you, he will see that they get justice, and quickly. However, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on the earth?" (Luke 18:7-8, NIV).

Let us pray

God promises justice for those who cry out to Him in prayer. Bring the injustices that you see in your community and city before God in prayer.

Cast all the cares and anxiety concerning these matters on God, knowing that He cares for us (Philippians 4:6, 1 Peter 5:7).

Ask for the Church to remain faithful in prayer until Jesus returns and not to grow weary. Pray for prayer lives to be revived; for many to turn away from their unbelief and to start seeking God with faith in their hearts (Hebrews 11:6).

WEDNESDAY: 22 MARCH 2023

WATCH DAILY

Blessed is the man who listens to me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors. For whoever finds me finds life, and obtains favor from the LORD... (Proverbs 8:34-35).

Let us pray

Pray for Christians to take time out of their daily schedules to seek God's face in prayer. Also, pray for people who have become overwhelmed by the cares of this world and have neglected their time with God. Ask the Holy Spirit to minister to them and revive their hearts to seek God wholeheartedly again. Pray for each person who is part of a 24-7 prayer group in your nation. Ask the Spirit of wisdom and revelation to open their eyes to know the hope of God's calling for their lives (Ephesians 1:17-18).

THURSDAY: 23 MARCH 2023

BE SOUND MINDED AND ALERT

But the end and culmination of all things has now come near; keep sound minded and self-restrained and alert therefore for [the practice of] prayer. (1 Peter 4:7, AMPC).

Let us pray

Earnestly pray for hopeless people and for many who are experiencing defeat. Pray for them to gird up the loins of their minds and put their hope fully on God's grace (1 Peter 1:13). Ask the Holy Spirit to help us, the church, grow in self-control, and not be swayed from God's truth by emotions, trials, or difficulty, but to continually come before God in prayer with hope and faith in our hearts. Ask the Lord to revive the hearts of the young generation of believers so that they will be sober of mind, vigilant and resist the devil by remaining steadfast in the faith (1 Peter 5:8-9).

FRIDAY: 24 MARCH 2023

STRENGTHEN THE THINGS THAT REMAIN

"And to the angel of the church in Sardis write, 'These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars: "I know your works, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead. Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die, for I have not found your works perfect before God. (Revelation 3:1-2).

Let us pray

Pray for the church to remain watchful, and not fall into the trap of religious acts and works only. Ask for discernment to see where we have gone astray. Ask God to raise watchmen in every congregation to be watchful in prayer. Pray for every ministry to be brought before the Lord again for His approval and correction, to strengthen areas where negligence has crept in.

SATURDAY: 25 MARCH 2023

THE LORD BUILDS THE HOUSE

Unless the LORD builds the house, they labor in vain who build it; unless the LORD guards the city, the watchman stays awake in vain. (Psalm 127:1).

Let us pray

Pray for the global prayer ministries and 24-7 prayer networks in your nation. Ask for leaders of these ministries to remain reliant on God for prayer strategies in their nations.

Lift your nation before God in prayer and ask Him for a prayer movement in homes, schools and congregations. Also, pray for the Christians to co-labour with the Lord in prayer.

Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord. (1 Corinthians 15:58).

SUNDAY: 26 MARCH 2023

THE BRIDEGROOM IS COMING

"Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming." (Matthew 25:13).

Let us pray

Call on God, praying for Christians in your country to obediently follow the leading of the Holy Spirit and the instruction from His Word daily. Pray that they will not stagnate in their relationships, but abide in Jesus (John 15: 4-5).

Pray for the church to remain watchful in prayer, consistently shining her light in this world (Matthew 5:13-16) and be expectant for the return of the Lord even when scoffed or ridiculed (2 Peter 3:4).

Ask the Holy Spirit to awaken our hearts to share the gospel with the lost; to be sensitive to His prompting to tell others about Jesus.
