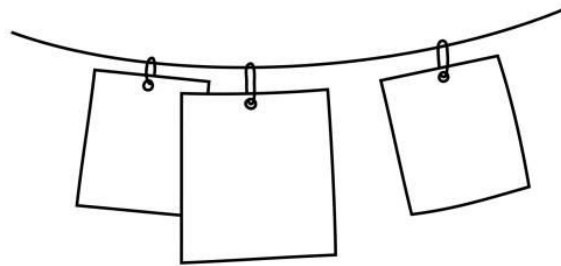
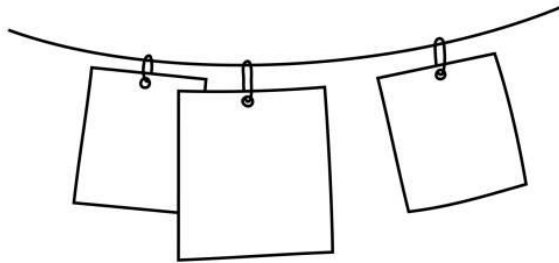


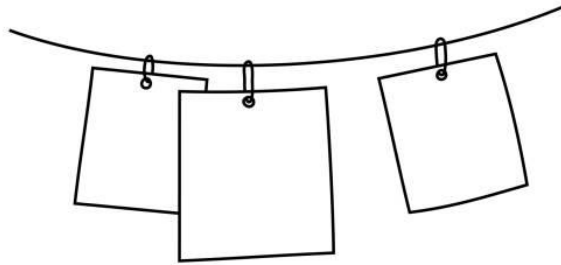

Guidelines

Petition

noun

1. a formal written request, typically one signed by many people, appealing to authority in respect of a particular cause.

verb

1. present a petition to (an authority) in respect of a particular cause.

Ephesians 6:18

“With all prayer and petition pray [with specific requests] at all times [on every occasion and in every season] in the Spirit, and with this in view, stay alert with all perseverance and petition [interceding in prayer] for all God’s people.” - Amp

How to?

Post personal prayer requests for unsaved friends, colleagues, or personalities here. You can also post personal prayer requests for people who know the Lord Jesus but are going through difficult times.

- Write down their name on a piece of paper and stick it on the wall or use the pegs and stick it to the string. Use initials or another name if you don't want to use their name or names. You can also just dot down the prayer request anonymously.

- Pray for their salvation
- Pray for their deliverance
- Pray for their healing
- Pray for spiritual breakthroughs
- Pray for financial breakthroughs

10 Salvation Scriptures to Pray

1. CONVICTION (John 16:8-11): *He (the Spirit) shall convict the world of sin...righteousness and judgement.*

2. SPIRITUAL QUICKENING (John 6:63): *It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.*

3. A SURGE OF FAITH (Ephesians 2:8): *For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,*

4. THEIR EYES TO OPEN (2 Corinthians 4:4-6): *...whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them. 6 For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.*

5. THEIR EARS TO HEAR (Revelation 3:20): *Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.*

6. GOD'S WORD TO PENETRATE THE HEART (Hebrews 4:12): *For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.*

7. HARDNESS OF HEART TO BE REMOVED (Jeremiah 23:29): *"Is not My word like a fire?" says the LORD, "And like a hammer that breaks the rock in pieces?"*

8. BONDAGE TO SIN BROKEN (John 8:36): *Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.*

9. THE FATHER TO DRAW THEM (John 6:44): *No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day.*

10. THE FATHER TO SHOW MERCY (Romans 9:16): *It is not of him that wills, nor of him that runs, but God who shows mercy.*
